Part 6: The Enemy Within

Big Idea: The greatest threat to the church isn't outside forces—it's division within.

Opening Question:

- Think of a time you experienced deep unity with a group of people. What made it so powerful?
- Why do you think people today are often more loyal to **political**, **social**, **or national identities** than to their faith?
- Have you ever seen division weaken a church or Christian community? What happened? **Scripture Exploration**:

• Read John 17

- Jesus prays for His followers to be one, just as He and the Father are one.
- Why do you think unity was Jesus' greatest concern for His followers?
- What does this passage reveal about how division impacts the credibility of the church?

Read John 13:34

- Why does Jesus make love for each other the defining mark of His followers?
- What makes this command difficult when we disagree with other Christians?
- What does it look like to love people we strongly disagree with?

• Read Luke 2:11

- If Jesus is King, what does that mean for our political, cultural, and personal loyalties?
- In what ways do we sometimes let secondary issues (politics, culture, social movements) take priority over Jesus?
- O How can we keep Jesus as King in the way we engage with the world?

Going Deeper:

- Jesus prayed for unity—why is it so hard for the church to live it out?
- What are some warning signs that we're allowing division to distract us from Jesus?
- If non-believers looked at the way Christians interact online and in culture today, what do you think they would assume about Jesus?
- How can we demonstrate unity without ignoring important issues?

Personal Application:

- What's one step you can take this week to pursue unity in your own faith community?
 - Example: Have a conversation with someone you disagree with, choose grace over argument, or pray for someone you struggle to love.
- Is there a person or group you've struggled to love because of their beliefs or actions?
 - How can you respond differently in a way that reflects Jesus?
- What would change in your life if you truly pledged loyalty to Jesus above everything else?

Final Thoughts & Prayer:

Imagine if the church was known not for its divisions, but for its love and unity. How would that change how the world sees Jesus?

Let's pray for God to give us the courage to love, the humility to listen, and the wisdom to pursue unity without compromising truth.
