Discussion Questions

- Did you ever wear a WWJD, FROG or other type of wristband when they were in fashion? If you did, what did you wear?
- Share an instance when you were unsure of what to say or do in a situation. How did you decide on your course of action?
- When you hear the phrase "What would Jesus do?", what situations or relationships come to mind? Why do you think those stand out?
- Read John 13:34-35 together. What key phrases stand out to you and why?
 - How does Jesus describe love in this passage? What does this imply about how we should treat others, especially when we're unsure of what to say or do?
- Read 1 Corinthians 13:4-7. Which one of these characteristics do you struggle with the most? How does it impact your ability to love others?
- Both passages emphasize love as central to Christian life. Why do you think it can become so easy for Jesus followers to hear these verses and not be moved to action?
- Think of a current situation where you're unsure of what to say or do. Based on today's discussion, what does love require of you in this instance?
