P Big Idea

When you see Jesus differently, you see life differently.

Key Scriptures

• Luke 24:13-35

Discussion Questions

- Can you think of a time when you misjudged someone—or were surprised by who they turned out to be? What happened?
- Have you ever had to "rethink" your view of Jesus? What led to that shift?
- What are some of the ideas or expectations about Jesus that you were handed growing up—or absorbed from culture?
- Read Luke 24:13-35. As you listened to or read the story of the Emmaus road, what grabbed your attention or stirred your curiosity?
- The two disciples didn't recognize Jesus walking with them (v.16). What do you think might have been going on there—and how do you relate to that in your own life?

- Have there been times where you've felt like God was distant, only to realize later
 He was closer than you thought?
- The disciples said, "We had hoped..." (v.21). How do those three words hit you?
 - What hopes or expectations have you carried into your faith journey—about God, life, or how things "should" turn out?
- Jesus responds by walking them through Scripture (v.27). Why do you think He chose to do that instead of revealing Himself right away?
 - What does that tell us about how Jesus meets people in their questions or doubts?
- Later, when they recognize Jesus, they say their hearts were burning (v.32). What do you think that moment meant for them?
 - Have you ever had a moment where something clicked spiritually—or where
 Jesus became more real to you?

Challenge Question (For Takeaway):

What would it look like for you to take a fresh look at Jesus this week? (What step could you take? What assumptions might you need to set aside?)
