



Part 1: Image is Everything

Key Scripture: Genesis 1:26, 2:18-20; Matthew 12:47-48; John 15:12-13

Discussion Questions

Ice-Breaker

- Share a recent moment when you felt a strong sense of belonging or connection. What made that moment special?
- What's one activity that always makes you feel better when you're feeling isolated?

Deep Dive

- Discuss the Genesis account of creation. How does the concept of being made in God's image (Imago Dei) influence our need for community?
- Reflect on John 15:12-13. How does Jesus' command to love one another challenge and redefine our approach to relationships?
- How does the modern issue of loneliness relate to the biblical statement that "it is not good for man to be alone"?
- Can you relate to the feelings of invisibility or insignificance discussed in the message? How does community help address these feelings?

Application

- What are some barriers to building meaningful relationships in your life? How can you overcome them this week?
- Identify a step you can take this week to initiate or deepen a relationship. Why is intentional connection important in your spiritual journey?
