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### **Big Idea**

We don't just attend church. We build a home.

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### **Key Scriptures**

- **Luke 19:1-10**
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### **Discussion Questions**

- Share a time someone helped you move from hello to home (remembered your name, your order, invited you to a table). What made it feel different?
- Where have you experienced people being fast with labels and slow with names in your life?
  - How has the shaped the way you see people?
- What are some labels we use (or wear) to keep people at arm's length? What changes when we learn a name instead?
- **Read Luke 19:10**
  - What stands out to you from this passage? What questions do you have?
  - What resistance might we feel if "notorious sinners" show up, and how do we respond like Jesus?

- In verse 8, Zacchaeus stands and changes his life. What does that tell us about where real discipleship happens?
    - How does Jesus' mission in verse 10 shape what our church should celebrate most?
  - In your own words, what's the difference between a church that says hello and a church that feels like home?
  - "We grow at the pace of relationships." Where have you seen that be true (personally or in community)?
  - Who is someone in your life who is currently sitting in a tree observing Jesus? If you feel comfortable, share that name with the group so they can be praying for them.
