Part 5: The Wonder of It All

Big Idea: The message of the church is a message for the world.

Opening Question:

- What's something you used to be amazed by as a child but now take for granted?
- Have you ever been deeply moved by someone's story of faith? What made it so powerful?
- Do you think people today struggle to be excited about their faith? Why/why not?

Scripture Exploration:

- **Read Acts 5:17-42:** *"The apostles left the Sanhedrin, rejoicing because they had been counted worthy of suffering disgrace for the Name."*
 - What does their reaction to suffering tell us about their perspective on faith?
 - Their suffering didn't kill their faith—it deepened it. How can we develop that same kind of resilience today?
- **Read Acts 9:1-19**
 - Why do you think Jesus personally identifies with His followers being persecuted?
 - What does this reveal about God's closeness to His people?
- **Read 2 Timothy 2:1-10**
 - How does Paul's confidence in the gospel challenge the way we think about obstacles in our own lives?
 - What does this verse teach us about the unstoppable nature of God's mission?

Going Deeper:

- Paul never lost his wonder despite suffering immensely for his faith. How do we know when we've lost our wonder? What are some common warning signs?
- The early church was an **outward-facing, multi-cultural, multiplying movement**—how does that compare to the way we see church today?
- Paul said in **Romans 5:8**, *"While we were still sinners, Christ died for us."* How can reflecting on God's grace reignite our passion for faith?
- What would change in your life if you truly lived with the **joy and wonder** of the early church?
- How can we help others rediscover the **wonder of following Jesus**?

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Personal Application:

- What's one step you'll take this week to rekindle your wonder? (Example: Start each day with gratitude, share your faith with someone, spend time reflecting on Jesus' love.)
- Is there someone in your life who may be spiritually disconnected? How can you **share the message of Jesus** with them in a fresh way?
- Let's pray for the courage to see faith with **fresh eyes**—as if we were hearing the good news for the first time.

Final Thoughts & Prayer:

- **Imagine if we got our wonder back.** How might it change our families, churches, and communities?
- Let's pray for a renewed sense of **gratitude, excitement, and urgency** to share Jesus with the world.
